

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022-1

**AN ORDINANCE REPLACING CHAPTER 14 OF TITLE 3
and
REPEALING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 7
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROSEVILLE, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Title 3, Chapter 14 of the Roseville, Illinois Code of Ordinances is hereby replaced with the following:

Title 3 "Business," Chapter 14 "Residential Waste"


Section 3-14-1. Village authorities are authorized to enter into contracts for more than one year and no more than 30 years relating to the collection and final disposition, or relating solely to either the collection or final disposition of garbage, refuse and ashes.

Section 3-14-2. The contract referred to in Section 3-14-1 may provide that the methods of collection and final disposition of garbage, refuse and ashes shall be the exclusive methods of collection and final disposition of garbage, refuse and ashes within the corporate limits of the Village.

Section Two. Title 7, Chapter 2 of the Roseville, Illinois Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed.


Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30)^{day} from and after its passage and approval.


